ROCKIT Productions is the home of Musical Theatre training on Redlands Coast, with community engagement stretching throughout South East Queensland.

Both a production company and an educational institution, ROCKIT Productions is the fusion of arts training and entertainment production, working with students in extra curricular formats, in-school workshops, holiday intensives and corporate entertainment.

Commencing classes with students as young as 2 Years old in our **Pre-Primary Program (READY, SET, DANCE!)**, through to senior grades, there are multiple pathways for student development within the arts from before school, to graduation, and beyond.

Each year the ROCKIT team produce a series of musical productions with our **Musical Theatre Programs** for our student groups including the **RUGRATS** (Prep - Grade 2), **JUNIORS** (Grade 3-6), **ELEMENTARIES** (Grade 7-8), **INTERMEDIATES** (Grade 9), and **SENIORS** (Grade 10-12).

We boost an impressive **DANCE STUDIO** Timetable with classes in Jazz, Ballet, Tap, Street, Contemporary, Heels, Fit&Flex and Deep Stretch. Our classes are carefully curated and tailored to suit varying levels of ability, ranging from primary-aged students to beginner teens in our "Intro-To" classes, all the way to our "Pre-Professional" sessions designed for our most advanced dancers.

Our **MUSIC STUDIO** features multiple **VOCAL** teachers specialising in Contemporary Musical Theatre along with **GUITAR** and **PIANO** and our **ACTOR'S STUDIO** runs weekly sessions focusing on finding truth, character development and text analysis.

ROCKIT Productions is also thrilled to be offering nationally recognised **Certificate Courses** for students from Grade 10 and above with our partner, Empowerdance PTY LTD (RTO: 40397).





OUR STUDIO



ROCKIT Productions is located at 36 Old Cleveland Road, Capalaba QLD, 4157.

Our fully air-conditioned facility offers three large-group studios and two private music studios totalling over 500m2. In addition, we have a student kitchen equipped with a chilled water fountain, microwave and kettle. Our costume department boasts an extensive collection of over 10,000 costumes, and we offer a supervised waiting area. All conveniently located just 25 minutes from Brisbane City.

Our ballet and contemporary space features sprung flooring, Tarkett, ballet barres, and floor-to-ceiling mirrors. The performance space (also known as The Launchpad Theatre) is equipped with sprung floors, floor-to-ceiling mirrors, and the flexibility to transform into an 88-seat tiered theatre. It is outfitted with theatrical lighting, curtaining, and a state-of-the-art short-throw projector. Our large-group vocal and acting studio features beautiful natural light and is furnished with a Yamaha digital piano. For private music sessions, the ROCKIT Music studios include Yamaha digital pianos, acoustic paneling, LED-glamour mirrors, and comfortable lounge seating.

VENUE POLICIES



DROP OFF/PICK UP

Students in primary school should be escorted to and from the foyer by a parent/guardian for Drop-Off and return for Pick-Up. High school students may be dropped off in the carpark but must only depart the venue in groups of 3 or more, otherwise a ROCKIT Team Leader will accompany you. Please avoid congregating in the stair well as this is a fire hazard.

CLOSED DOOR POLICY

We run all of our classes with a closed door policy to allow the students to focus on their training without distraction. Parents and Guardians are free to leave after classes commence and return upon finish times, or alternatively wait for the duration of the class in the foyer.

STAIR USAGE

Please be reminded we are located on the first floor which requires the use of 20 stairs with hand rails available. If you have any concerns about accessibility, please let us know. We understand this is not ideal and sincerely apologise for any inconvenience or distress this may cause. Please reach out if you need to discuss this further.

PARKING

There is ample parking in the area, though please be aware of time limits in certain areas as carparks differ along Old Cleveland Road and its side streets.

P-PLATERS

We ask all student drivers to please park in the main car-park as close to the studio as you can. If the main car park is full, there is ample space at the bottom of the hill, near the football club. When heading back to your car at the end of the day, please do so in groups of 3 or more. If this is not an option, please ask a ROCKIT Team Leader to walk with you.

MEAL BREAKS

We encourage students to remain upstairs in between class times. When outside the building, students are not chaperoned and are therefore out of our duty of care. Please set expectations with your child regarding whether they are permitted to leave the building to get food or snacks in between sessions.

On show days or full day rehearsals on weekends, written consent by way of text or email is required before students (High School Age and older only) leave the building. Students leaving the building are recommended to travel with one or more persons.

TRAINING CONSENT FORM

All enrolled students are required to complete a Training Consent Form each year. This includes medical details, media consent and emergency contact information

The team are here to provide guidance and we have a variety of teaching practises and processes in place, built from over a decade of experience and finetuning within our programs. We ask students and parents to respect our team and their decisions, however if you would like clarification or feedback, please just ask.
- What Makes Us Different Makes Us Strong: We all have individual differences including our previous training, skills and abilities, knowledge, experience, and of course our unique personalities. We must build each other up, support one another, and take every opportunity to learn from each other and grow as a team.
- YOU are ROCKIT: Yes it starts with the ROCKIT Team members, but please remember, YOU are ROCKIT too. The people are the heartbeat of this place and together we share the responsibility of creating a welcoming environment that celebrates all student uniqueness, abilities, and backgrounds. ROCKIT Productions is an inclusive community and all are entitled to work and learn together free from any form of harassment. Discrimination based on gender, sexuality, religious beliefs, cultural and ethnic background, neurodiversity, or values is not acceptable. Everyone here is treated equally and with fairness.
- Zero Tolerance for Bullying: Students are responsible for their own behaviour and actions. - **Student Communication:** We run a closed-door policy for classes and rehearsals, however we encourage students to talk about about conversations in the studio, particularly relating to events, schedules, forms required, or updates provided during this time.
- **Time is Key:** Arrive to class on time and if you can't make it, let the ROCKIT Team know in advance by emailing us at absent@rockitproductions.com.au

- Come Prepared: Commit to professional growth by arriving prepared for classes/ rehearsals. Please bring your class materials every week: correct uniform, water bottle, script/score (if applicable), pencil and eraser, notebook, portable computer (if applicable) and adequate snacks/refreshments.
- On Time Pick-Up: Ensure students are picked up within 15 minutes of the conclusion of class. In an emergency please contact George: 0407 266 583.
- **Dress the Part:** Dress appropriately for rehearsals or performances according to the 'Uniform Policy' and 'Specific Show Requirements'. We'll send you the details via email throughout the term.
- Student, Staff, and Visitor Safety: ROCKIT Productions is committed to ensuring a safe and healthy environment for everyone involved. We're all about safe dance practices and regular professional development to keep improving our safety standards. Plus, we're fully compliant with First Aid and CPR requirements.
- We're all in this together: Take a look at the student ROCKIT Code of Ethics to understand what we expect from our students.
- Termination of Enrolment: Unacceptable behaviour from an enrolled student will
 result in termination of their enrolment. A student's behaviour may be considered to be
 unacceptable when they:
 - Breach the Student Code of Conduct
 - Are disruptive and disrespectful
 - Display threatening behaviour towards others
 - Engage in harassment of any kind
 - Vape or smoke on premises
 - Wilfully steal or damage property belonging to ROCKIT Productions, team members, clients, or fellow students



A DAY AT ROCKIT



WHAT TO BRING

- ROCKIT Uniform (Please see below for more specifics on this)
- Water Bottle
- Pencil and Eraser (To take notes during class. Please do not bring a pen)
- Deodorant (Spray outside, downstairs)
- Snacks. If you are in the studio for a long period of time please make ensure you bring enough food to sustain you for the afternoons classes. Students training in the evenings are encouraged to utilise check-in time for dinner breaks.

UNIFORM

- Branded ROCKIT Uniform T-shirt or Tank
 - If wearing a tank, please wear a black supportive sports bra or equivalent underneath
- Basic black sports attire or active wear on lower half
 - (Please avoid baggy track pants so teachers can see knee movements for safe dance practise. We suggest sport shorts, leggings, or light athleisure style pants / trousers)
- Black or white socks (Branded socks available)
- Branded Uniform Jacket
- Fully enclosed footwear to be worn at all times (See below)
- Further branded items are also available via our ONLINE STORE but are not compulsory.

RETIRED UNIFORMS

Blue Hoodies, 'Rocky' Tank, and Blue Logo Tees are retired and no longer permitted in the studio.

ONLINE STORE

Within the Online Store, purchases can be made for branded uniform items. Orders usually take one week to fulfil before being ready for pick up at the studio. Jackets are custom orders and require 4-5 weeks lead time.

ABSENCES

If a student is ill or unable to make it to class, please send an email to let us know via: absent@rockitproductions.com.au If you are sick, please stay home. This applies for performances as well as rehearsals. We understand that this is a part of life, so please just let us know.

Absences from performance events or group classes (Dance, Drama, Musical Theatre, Vocal Ensembles, Shared Vocal Lessons, etc) do not qualify for make-up lessons or refunds.

Music Studio Absences (Private Lessons)

We understand that some absences such as illness and school events cannot be avoided. As such, we will endeavour to schedule make-up lessons for any absences notified (via email to absent@rockitproductions.com.au) before 12:00pm (Midday) the day before your lesson. Absent notices received after this time will result in a forfeited lesson. Make-up lessons cannot be carried on to the next term. Please note that we cannot guarantee all make-up lessons will be awarded, as we are required to pay venue hire and staffing fees regardless of student attendance. In the unlikely event that ROCKIT Productions cancels your scheduled lesson, we will provide a make-up lesson or a credit note to the value of the lesson to be used the following term.

TIMETABLE

The full studio timetable is ever-evolving, with new classes added each year. We run open style classes as opposed to following a set syllabus, which allows us to tailor the schedule for our student base.

DOUBLE CASTING

As part of our commitment to creating diverse performance opportunities for our students, we sometimes opt to share roles between students we have found were both deserving of the role. This is known as 'Double Casting'. Each student will perform in all scheduled performances, but sometimes in different roles.

In this scenario, students may play a featured character for some performances and an ensemble character in others. We will let you, your family, and the wider ROCKIT Community know in advance who will be performing in each show so they can purchase tickets accordingly.

Please remember though, you will be performing in ALL SHOWS ... yahoo!

MICROSOFT TEAMS (Our Student Portal)

Microsoft Teams serves as both our student hub and official method of communication. The app is available for free on iOS and Android devices.

The Show-Specific Teams Community provides access to practice materials in both dance and vocal. It houses rehearsal footage, tracks, sheet music, timetables and rehearsal schedules, as well as simple in-app communication directly and also as a cohort to post reminders about rehearsal dates, costume requirements, and other show-related info. Any correspondence with teachers should contain at least 2 teachers at all times.

As always, we ask that any content shared in the teams portal remain private and confidential and is for viewing by the enrolled students only. We ask students not to show the video to friends, family, or anyone outside of the production.

Students are required to create both a personal/non-school email account and a Microsoft Teams account with that email address. For more information and to download the app, head to the links below.

COSTUME MEASUREMENTS

All students in the Musical Theatre Performance Programs are required to fill out a Costume Measurement Form. We understand that measurements change, however we ask that you fill these out in the first three weeks of the semester so that we can order your various costume pieces.

All you'll need is a tape measure and 5 minutes with the participating student. Please complete in centimetres (cm) and try to be as accurate as possible. A zero in the wrong place can cause a lot of chaos! Please ask the student to breathe normally while taking measurements; holding their breath or trying to suck in doesn't help anyone. We don't care what size you are, we just want to make sure your costumes fit beautifully and you feel amazing on stage.

COSTUME HIRE

As a part of our Musical Theatre Programs we charge a costume hire fee rather than a large costume purchase fee for every item your child appears in. Therefore ROCKIT provides the majority of your costume items, we just ask you provide personal items like shoes, socks and undergarments.

Occasionally we may ask students to provide costume items such as casual clothes or long black pants, depending on what the character needs. We try to ensure these are items you already have, can borrow easily or buy from an op shop.

We go through every student's measurements and make sure we order a costume with that student in mind. It is our goal that the student feels comfortable in the costume and suits the character they are playing. We take a lot of time and care in these decisions.

UNDERGARMENTS

Dressing rooms are shared spaces with no close toilet cubicle access. In most shows there are some VERY quick changes taking place between items. In keeping with our child safety policies, we ask that all students provide a simple base to wear underneath their costumes.

YOUNGER STUDENTS

These items include **Black Bike Shorts** for all students and either a **Beige Crop Tops** (female students) or a **Singlet** (Beige Shoestring for females, white tank for males & NB performers).

OLDER STUDENTS

Older students are encouraged to bring multiple options to suit different costumes. Items include...

FEMALE STUDENTS

- Black bike pants
- Black underwear
- White underwear
- Black sports bra
- Black supportive bra
- White supportive bra
- Beige supportive bra

MALE/NB STUDENTS

- Supportive black underwear (No visible waist band)
- Singlet or tank (this is optional)

HAIR AND MAKEUP

Some shows require specific hair and makeup solutions but during most shows, students will play multiple characters throughout the performance, so a neutral look is required.

LONG HAIR

Two, clean, secure braids. Please use hairspray and product to keep style in place. Please also bring bobby pins to secure the ends of the braids flat on the head if needed for wigs.

SHORT HAIR

Neat and secure style, please use product to keep the style in place.

MAKEUP

Very simple, natural coverage to help add definition under the lights.

As part of our commitment to covid safety, we ask you do all of this at home. Parents and guardians aren't allowed backstage or into the dressing rooms for safety reasons and makeup / hair items cannot be shared amongst cast members. If Hair and Make-up is not a strong skill set within your family, please let us know how we can help.

DRESS REHEARSALS

The phrase "dress rehearsal" refers to a rehearsal where the cast rehearse the show in costume as if it were a performance, integrating props and small set pieces but without the full technical aspects such as lighting or large set pieces. All cast are required to bring the aforementioned undergarments and all show footwear or other required costume items for these rehearsals... please don't forget your socks! (**PRO TIP:** Pack a backup pair)

Please note, parents are not permitted backstage.

FOOD - These rehearsal are usually only a few hours long so pack some light snacks.

TECHNICAL REHEARSALS

The phrase "technical rehearsal" or "tech" refers to a rehearsal in which all technical aspects are added to the show including light, set, projection, sound and props. At ROCKIT, we also utilise these rehearsals for production photography so all cast are required to perform in full costumes, hair and makeup. Don't forget those undergarments, socks and deodorant!

These rehearsals are not just about bringing everything together, they're also about safety. The nature of working in the theatre means we do a lot of our work in the dark, with moving set pieces, cables and curtaining completely transforming the space, which can feel somewhat disorienting at times. As part of our Risk Management Strategies we work with students in full-light, low-light, and blackout states to ease them into the working environment. Students who miss tech day will not be permitted onstage for performance until they have completed a full safety induction with a member of the ROCKIT team. This may not be possible until after the first performance.

We endeavour to keep these rehearsals as "on-time" as possible but we can never predict when a computer is going to go on strike or a moving light goes rogue. We ask you please be patient and forgive us if we run a little over on these days!

Please note, parents are not permitted backstage.

FOOD - These rehearsals can be very long days and exact breaks times fluctuate at the mercy of technical requirements, so students are not able to leave the building on these days. Please pack for meal breaks, snacks and drinks. (**PRO TIP:** Students in bigger dance shows often bring a Gatorade for some electrolytes or some red frogs for a quick sugar hit).

SHOW DAY

Each "show day" can look a little different. Each age group has shows at different times with different call times on each of these days so you will receive a detailed email with all the relevant information in the weeks leading up to your production.

All students should arrive 10mins before call time with full hair and makeup completed before arrival. Please remember all undergarments, footwear, socks and deodorant.

FOOD - These days have larger breaks so we permit students to leave the venue with family (permission required) to enjoy the many eateries we have surrounding the venue. Students in Grades 10-12 who have parental permission (emailed to hello@rockitproductions.com.au) are permitted to leave the building to purchase lunch in small groups. We also have a fully supervised eating area for all breaks for students who have packed meals or for those waiting for food drop-offs. We even schedule a nap break for our youngest students!

(**PRO TIP:** We suggest students in dance-heavy shows bring an electrolyte drink, some lollies for a quick sugar hit, as well as wearing anti-chaff cream for those long, sweaty days!

TICKETING

We endeavour to have tickets available for purchase 2 weeks out from the opening show. You will receive a detailed email with all relevant information prior to tickets being launched.

We use an online ticketing system to ensure you choose the seat of your liking with a seamless check-in process when you arrive for the show. Once on sale, immediate family are given priority access with any further tickets made available to the wider community after this pre-sale window closes.

Our production team weave their magic to create an 88-seat tiered seating bank for our audience, transforming Studio 3 into the Launchpad Theatre, a functional theatre space outfitted with theatrical sound, lighting, set, curtaining and a state-of-the-art short-throw projector.

Tickets are in high demand so make sure you sort out your group bookings early!

PRODUCTION STILLS AND VIDEOGRAPHY

During our Technical Rehearsals we have a professional photographer taking photos of the show. We know these 'show memories' can last a lifetime and we believe every student involved in this experience should have access to show stills so we make these **available free of charge** via our Flikr page. 
AUDIENCE FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY
